

MUSIC MINISTRIES AT ST. PAUL'S

CHERUB CHOIR (K4 & K5)

P4 Tuesdays, 11:00 - 11:20 AM (begins Sept. 29, 2009)

K5 Tuesdays, 11:50 - 12:10 AM (begins Sept. 29, 2009)

An introduction into the choir setting based on Christian music and movement for our youngest group.

CHIMETONES (Grades 1, 2)

Tuesdays, 3:00 - 4:00 PM (begins Sept. 29, 2009)

The Chimetones are a special group. They learn to play music as a choir using metal bars called Choirchimes. (These cousins of the handbells are easier for the younger students to control.)

CHILDREN'S BELL CHOIR (Grades 3 & Up)

Tuesday, 4:15 - 5:00 PM (begins Sept. 29, 2009)

The older students in this group learn to play music together as a team. Everyone in the bell choir has a special role to play.

YOUTH PRAISE CHOIR (Grades 6 & Up)

Thursday, 6:30 - 7:15 PM (begins Sept. 24, 2009)

This group sings contemporary Christian music in unison and parts. Fun and fellowship, as well as service work, keep these students singing for the Lord.

PRAISE TEAM

Thursdays, 7:30 - 9:30 PM (continues through year)

The Praise Team and its Worship Assistants lead the congregational singing at the Contemporary Service every Sunday.

ADULT BELL CHOIR

Wednesdays, 8:00 - 9:00 PM (begins Sept. 23, 2009)

This amazing group works together to create anthems by ringing handbells.

HERITAGE CHOIR

Wednesdays, 7:00 - 8:00 PM (begins Sept. 9, 2009)

This group rehearses traditional 4 part anthems for the 8:00AM Heritage service. Devotions and prayers are shared weekly, creating a warm, loving, atmosphere.

BRASS CHOIR

Saturday Rehearsals are seasonal. This group is scheduled to play for festival services throughout the year.

INSTRUMENTALISTS

Rehearsals scheduled as needed. Special music is prepared to enhance worship services.

CANTORS/ SONG LEADERS

This program helps to lead the congregation in song, as well as teach new hymns in services.

ACCOMPANISTS

Accompanists are needed for all choirs! Opportunities to play pre service, preludes or offerings are also available.
