## **COKE REWARDS**

If you drink Coke products and do not save the Coke rewards points for yourself, please consider donating them to the school. The 2008-2009 school year we collected 12,000 points and were able to redeem them for art supplies. For the coming year we have a goal of 25,000 points! Each cap is worth 3 points, 12 packs are worth 10 points and cases are worth 25. The reward code for the 12 packs is printed on the inside of the tear off portion of the cardboard. For the cases, the code is on the inside of the plastic wrapper around the case. You can place your codes in the collection basket or in the red Coke Rewards collection container by the school lost and found.
