Payment Plans

Single Payment Plan: Payment due by August 1st. Plan has a 2.5% discount on total tuition amount.

Three Payment Plan: Payments are due in July, November and March. There is a \$55 processing fee required, payable with your tuition agreement in June.

Eleven Payment Monthly Plan: Payments are due beginning in July and ending in May. There is a \$55 processing fee required, payable with your tuition agreement in June.

Payment plans are selected on your tuition agreement.

Tuition Fee Schedule

P3 Tuesday and Thursday:	\$1695	Additional children in the same family in grades Kindergarten through Eighth grade receive a \$200 discount on the yearly tuition rate.
P3 Monday, Wednesday and Friday:	\$2450	
P3 Monday through Friday:	\$3760	
Kindergarten:	\$6705	Middle school rates do not include fees for elective classes. Rates vary based on the electives selected by the student.
First through Fifth Grade:	\$6705	
Sixth through Eighth Grade:	\$7315	

St. Paul's offers in house tuition assistance, participates in the Maryland BOOST program and offers a family referral and SCRIP incentive program. Additional information is available in the School Office.

Overview

Requirements for Applying

All Grade Levels: Birth Certificate, uploaded to your online application or emailed to the School.

Grades 1st and Up: Copy of most recent report card, uploaded to your online application or emailed to the School.

Grades 1st and Up will be required to take an entrance exam before an application is submitted for review. Mrs. Boyd in Admissions will contact you after receiving your completed application.

If Applicable Only: Copy of active IEP or 504 Plan

Please Note: Applications are not considered complete until the online application has been completed in full, all required documents have been received by the school and the application fee paid. Space is not guaranteed until the application has been reviewed and formally accepted by the School. Application fees paid are non-refundable.
